Description: **Attack-level wind**

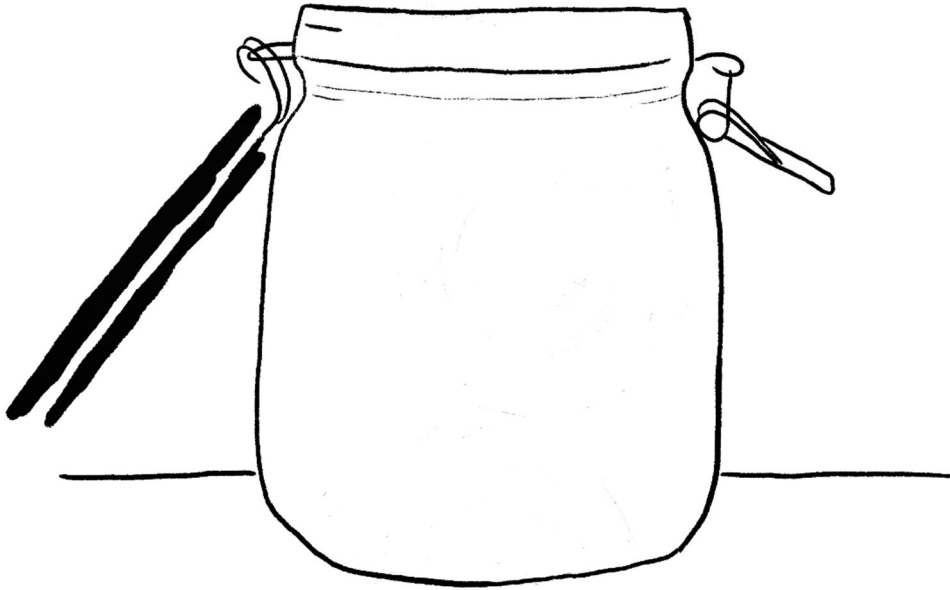
Can be used against even the largest storms.
